Background

- → The CARIFORUM-EU Economic Partnership Agreement, signed in 2008, is yet to enter into force but is being provisionally applied since 29 December 2008.
- The CF-EU EPA is comprehensive agreement encompassing not just a Trade in Goods regime, but also Trade in Services, Trade-related Issues and Development Cooperation.
- Implementation of the CF-EU EPA remains a top priority. However, CARIFORUM States face a number of obstacles, namely, institutional and operational capacity constraints and lack of financial and human resources to accommodate the increased demands related to the implementation of the Agreement.
- A key component to ensuring the success of the EPA is the adoption of appropriate measures to ensure that obligations are honoured and that the States are better positioned to take advantage of the Agreement. Attention to the legal and regulatory framework is therefore pivotal to the strengthening of the enabling environment.
